HOPWA is a program used to purchase and develop energy efficient housing units that provide safe, healthy, affordable and sustainable solutions for low income HIV-positive individuals and families.

The Town of Islip, who receives the funding, selected United Way of Long Island to administer the HOPWA program.

- HOPWA is a permanent housing solution for low income HIV-positive people in the region.
- Each housing project meets EPA Energy Star requirements and will save significantly on operational expenses.
- Through the efforts of the United Way of Long Island 50 HOPWA houses have been developed for more than 200 HIV-positive individuals and their families on Long Island.
