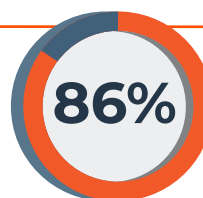
"As a mother of three, I did everything I could to keep the heat on. When I ran out of options, Project Warmth stepped in and gave my family the help we needed."

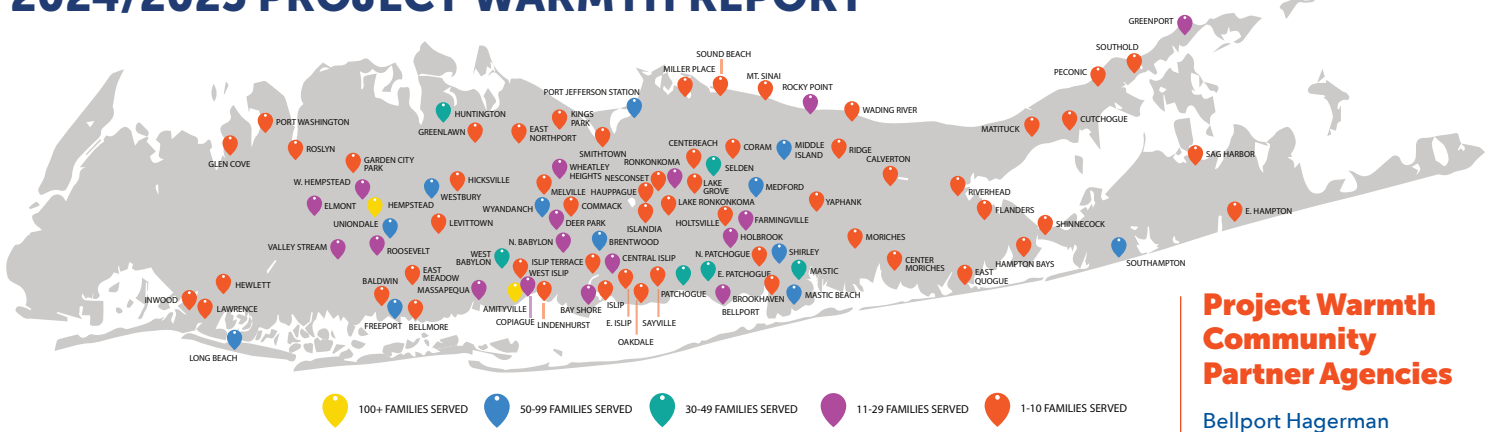

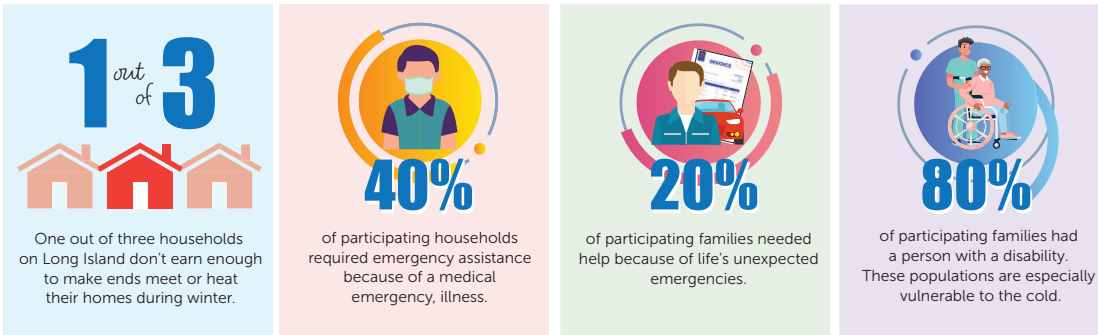
