

Sandy Victims Receive Support

The United Way of Long Island has awarded grants totaling \$350,000 to support the continuing long-term recovery efforts of local organizations that provide services for people affected by Superstorm Sandy.

The United Way of Long Island will draw the funds for these grants from an award made by the

American Red Cross in the end of last year. The organizations that have been chosen as recipients have dedicated their work to the areas of individual casework, housing assistance, interagency coordination and social service provider support. Among those awarded grants was Family Residences and Essential Enterprises Inc., Freeport Pride Inc. and Central Nassau Guidance and Counseling Services Inc.
